Position Summary: The Operator I supports the day to day field operations in the pipeline, tank farm operation, dock and rail car.

Position Responsibilities:

- Gain knowledge and experience in operations including Safe Work Practices, procedures and policies, facility-wide operations and routine maintenance.
- Perform truck/railcar unloading or dock duties in accordance with DOT regulations, company policies and procedures.
- Basic troubleshooting
- Knowledge of flow path thru facilities
- Able to read meters & gauge tanks
- Able to complete a normal pump start up and shut down
- Check for oil and water leaks, unusual noise and vibrations
- Operate facilities and systems to make and maintain proper
- Monitor and record daily readings
